

Choose one Rocks and Minerals song (you can listen to them on my website: Click “Science” and scroll down) to illustrate.

Use the attached lyrics to plan your illustrations. You don’t have to draw all of your images. Some can be pictures from the internet. If you find a picture that would go nicely, you can email it to me (just include your name, the picture, the song you are illustrating, and the verse number) or you can print it out.

Your goal is to have a visual image for each important idea from the song so that we can teach the science concepts. Some verses will need only one image. Some verses will require more. You may use the same image for more than one verse. Be creative - You might draw characters singing your song, or figure out a way for rocks or minerals to look like they are talking!

You may need to look up words in the dictionary or use your science book to help you figure out how to best illustrate the concepts.

We will take pictures of our images in class with the iPads and combine them with the songs to make simple music videos (no people in these). We want people to be entertained while also learning something about science. Therefore, you might want to add labels to some of your pictures to make the meaning more clear.

You will turn in the Music Video Planning Sheet on Monday, December 1. Use more paper if needed. You will also turn in your final draft images. If you need more paper, you can use some from home or wait to get more from me when we get back from Thanksgiving break.
