

Storybook Pumpkin Patch

The 1st grade is growing a storybook pumpkin patch! Decorate a pumpkin to look like one of your favorite characters by Wednesday, October 28th.

1) Think of your favorite book and design your pumpkin based on your favorite character from that book.

- **To make the pumpkin last longer, you may want to decorate *without* carving, cutting, or poking holes in it, but it is up to your family. 😊**
- **You can decorate with paint, but stay away from watercolors and spray paint. Acrylic paint or permanent markers work well.**
- **You can add materials (yarn, buttons, wiggly eyes, etc...).**

2) Complete the attached sheet, including a brief description of your character. Start your description under the author's name and continue to the second sheet if you need more room to write. You could start your description with: My favorite character is _____. Then, go on to say a few more sentences about the character. If possible, include what the character wants or what the character's problem is in the story.
