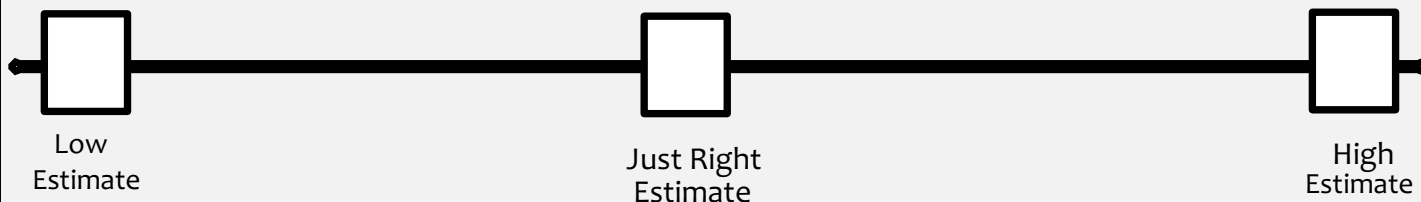


What did you notice (think about math)?

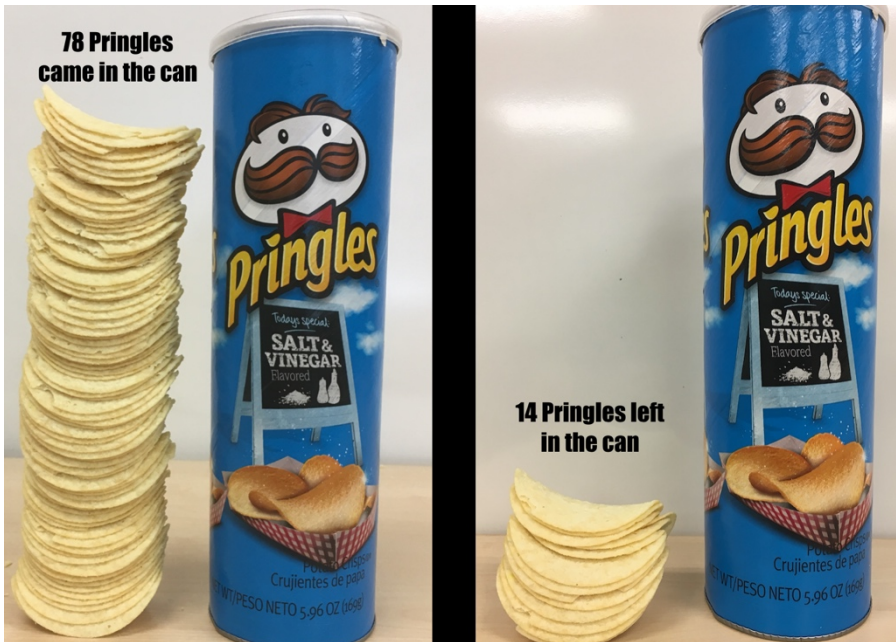
What do you wonder (think about math)?
